We are particularly interested in papers which convey thought leadership substantiated

by rigorous and credible research, and argumentation. We would like to hear from researchers, whose field of expertise is underrepresented in the field of educare, and wish to disseminate their research in a journal which has a distinct thematic focus on the interplay of care and education.

The journal is an international, double-blind peer-reviewed journal, published online only. It is an open access journal, offering free of charge publication to researchers and authors and free access to papers for readers. This is an in-house publication (published by Norland) which allows quick turnover of reviewing and publishing peerreviewed papers.
