2. Rationale for the module and its links with other modules

Links will be made to F&N 3.1 Celebration Cookery to demonstrate how ideas in this module can be integrated into party planning. Building on learning from ND 1.3 Let's Play! and ND 2.3 Playful Learning, students will consider the home environment as a place for displaying children's achievements. All of the learning in this module will be tied with Professional Development 3, as these skills will be called upon when students enter their NQN year.

3. Aims of the module

This module focuses on celebratory responsibilities nannies may have, such as party planning, celebrating children's learning in the home environment and fun ways to promote autonomy. By the end of the module, students will have practical party planning skills as well as being able to use the environment to effectively celebrate children's individuality and progress.
